theories utilitarian theories and rights based theories and finds them unconvincing he elaborates his own ethical theory constitutive theory which is derived from hegel and highlights the way in which we constitute one another as moral beings through a process of reciprocal recognition within a hierarchy of institutions which include the family civil society the state and the society of states

this text presents the concepts theories methods and traditions of ethical analysis and then applies them to case studies in the areas of human rights military force foreign intervention economic statecraft and global political justice
