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this volume charts the ways in which african american literature fosters transitions between material cultures and contexts from 1830 to 1850 and showcases work that explores how african american literature and lived experiences shaped one another chapters focus on the interplay between pivotal political and social events including emancipation in the west indies the irish famine and the fugitive slave act and key african american cultural productions such as the poetry of frances ellen watkins harper the writings of david walker and the genre of the slave narrative chapters also examine the relationship between african american literature and a variety of institutions including the press and the post office the chapters are grouped together in three sections each of which is focused on transitions within a particular geographic scale the local the national and the transnational taken together they offer a crucial account of how african americans used the written word to respond to and drive the events and institutions of the 1830s 1840s and beyond

have been written about him there is always more to say new aspects of his life to consider new facets of his persona to explore enlightening and entertaining exploring lincoln offers a selection of sixteen papers presented at the lincoln forum symposia over the past three years shining new light on particular aspects of lincoln and his tragically abbreviated presidency exploring lincoln presents a compelling snapshot of current lincoln scholarship and a fascinating window into understanding america's greatest president

from acclaimed historian john ferling the story of how thomas jefferson thomas paine and james monroe championed the most radical ideas of the american and french revolutions thomas jefferson thomas paine and james monroe were in the vanguard of revolutionary ideas in the 18th century as founding fathers they risked their lives for american independence but they also wanted more each wished for profound changes in the political and social fabric of pre 1776 america and hoped that the american revolution would spark republican and egalitarian revolutions throughout europe sweeping away the old monarchical order ultimately each rejoiced at the opportunity to be a part of the french revolution a cause that became untenable as idealism gave way to the bloody terror apostles of revolution spans a crucial period in western civilization ranging from the american insurgency against great britain to the declaration of independence from desperate engagements on american battlefields to the threat posed to the ideals of the revolution by the federalist party with the french revolution devolving into anarchy in the background the era culminates with the revolution of 1800 jefferson's election as president written as a sweeping narrative of a pivotal epoch apostles of revolution captures the turbulent spirit of the times and the personal dangers experienced by jefferson paine and monroe it reminds us that the liberty we take for granted is ours only because we both champions and common citizens have fought for it

examines the works of frederick douglass booker t washington w e b du bois and several other canonical figures to uncover a rich and vital tradition of black environmental thought from the abolition movement through the harlem renaissance provides the first careful linkage of the early conservation movement to black history the first detailed description of black agrarianism and the first analysis of scientific racism as an environmental theory

this book offers conclusions that are very different from most of the traditional historical interpretations of the buchanan presidency historians have either condemned buchanan for weakness and vacillation or portrayed him as a president dedicated to peace who did everything constitutionally possible to avoid war under the scrutiny of elbert b smith buchanan emerges as a strong figure who made vital contributions not to peace but to the accelerating animosities that produced the war historians who have considered the civil war a necessary and justifiable price for the destruction of slavery should feel a debt to james buchanan smith writes those who think the war could and should have been avoided owe him nothing most of the accounts of the era have concentrated on the dred scott case bleeding kansas and the lecompton constitution the lincoln douglas debates john brown the rise of the republicans and the disintegration of the democrats the election of 1860 and the bitter quarrels over slavery extension occasioned by these events buchanan has often appeared on a stage occupied by more important actors whether or not the war was already inevitable by march 1857 cannot be proved that a subsequent series of emotion packed events filled both north and south with rage and fear triggering secession and the war is undebatable it is smith s theory that buchanan in leading the united states through these fateful years added much to the war spirit that developed in both sections driven by affection and sympathy for the southerners he tried to satisfy their demands for slavery rights in the territories this aroused bitter anti south feelings throughout the north which foiled his efforts and further convinced the southerners that they could no longer have their way inside the union the one event that finally triggered the southern secession was the election of a republican president and buchanan s agreement with the southern demands and his personal hatred for stephen a douglas did much to accomplish this covering the most controversial period in american history smith presents important new evaluations for the consideration of students of both the civil war and the presidency
