in the early days of world war i germany unveiled a new weapon the mobile 42cm 16 5 inch m gerät howitzer at the time it was the largest artillery piece of its kind in the world and a closely guarded secret when war broke out two of the howitzers were rushed directly from the factory to liege where they quickly destroyed two forts and compelled the fortress to surrender after repeat performances at namur maubeuge and antwerp german soldiers christened the howitzers grosse or dicke berta fat or big bertha after bertha von krupp owner of the krupp armament

works that built the howitzers the nickname was soon picked up by german press which triumphed the 42cm howitzers as wunderwaffe wonder weapons and the legend of big bertha was born this book details the design and development of german siege guns before and during world war i accompanying the text are many rare never before published photographs of big bertha and the other german siege guns colour illustrations depict the most important aspects of the german siege artillery

following the defeat of france in the franco prussian war of 1870 71 the german army began to construct a fortress line from strasbourg to luxembourg to protect their new territory the centrepiece of which was the great moselstellung moselle position of metz thionville illustrated with rare photographs and full colour cutaway artwork this book examines the design and development of the fortress and analyses its use in combat focusing particularly on the part it played in holding up general patton s third army s advance across france in 1944

when war broke out between the united states and great britain in 1812 neither side was prepared for the conflict as evidenced by their respective fortifications the most sophisticated and modern fortifications were those built by the us corps of engineers to protect some of the main port cities these included fort mifflin in philadelphia fort mchenry in baltimore and castle william in new york the british also heavily fortified their main harbor at halifax and their main center of power at quebec however elsewhere especially in the interior fortifications were old neglected or only hastily erected the forts at detroit and mackinac were much as the british had left them in 1796 this book covers all of the main fortifications of the conflict those that faced the crashing of guns and those whose intimidation played a part in the grand strategy of the war

on 26 august 1071 a large byzantine army under emperor romanus iv met the saljuq turk forces of sultan alp arslan near the town of manzikert the battle ended in a decisive defeat for the byzantine forces with the byzantine emperor captured and much of his fabled varangian guard killed this battle is seen as the primary trigger of the crusades and as the moment when the power of the east roman or byzantine empire was irreparably broken the saljuq victory opened up anatolia to turkish islamic conquest which was eventually followed by the establishment of the ottoman state nevertheless the battle itself was the culmination of a christian byzantine offensive intended to strengthen the eastern frontiers of the empire and re establish byzantine domination over armenia and northern mesopotamia turkish saljuq victory was in no sense inevitable and might in fact have come as something of a surprise to those who achieved it it was not only the battle of manzikert that had such profound and far reaching consequences many of these stemmed from the debilitating byzantine civil war which followed and was a direct consequence of the defeat

when the romans withdrew from britain the north of the country was ruled by the mysterious ancient british race the picts much of what is known about these painted warriors comes from the remains of the fortifications that they left scattered around scotland although the picts are famous as sea raiders they were also subjected to attacks from a number of opponents to their south the romano british reoccupied the abandoned roman fortifications and hired saxon mercenaries to strike against the picts meanwhile from the west a new group the scoti attacked from ireland this book covers the fortification of the ancient picts in all their conflicts and discusses the importance of these sites as religious centres and seats of power while using up to date archaeological evidence to help unravel the mystery of this ancient race
