i hear you say that too yeah it s a nice and handy list but i do not know how to say or pronounce more than half of these drugs if not all you do not have to worry i have made a compilation of my audio lectures from my live classes to go with this ebook so memorizing drugs can really be this ridiculously easy and the link is inside the book repetition is key to remembering anything and by you carrying me i mean carrying this ebook with you everywhere you go you can pull it out anytime anywhere for a quick study or review that s why it s called a cheat sheet i will be with you everywhere you go i promise prof lohner
