Social expectations and gender politics thwarted ambitions and personal tragedy are played out against two contrasting historical backgrounds poignantly evoked by the atmospheric visual storytelling of award-winning graphic novel pioneer Bryan Talbot. Produced through an intense collaboration seldom seen between writers and artists *dotter of her father's eyes* is smart, funny, and a sad and essential addition to the evolving genre of graphic memoir. Bryan Talbot is recognized worldwide as one of the true original voices in graphic fiction. Bryan Talbot's *Grandville: Mon amour* was nominated for a 2011 Hugo Award.
