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the general aim of this book is to discuss a number of important and interrelated issues in life of modern man in medicine and the law that discussion is not only on material aspects of those issues but also on the forms of knowledge which enable us to develop the relevant arguments and to cope with related experiences in everyday life these issues are on the whole understood in terms of the law medicine relationship or the law and medicine interface however a reflexion on the philosophical and cultural basis of those expressions

shows the shortcomings of that approach and the need for an understanding of that relationship in terms of intertwining discourses

this volume is a contribution to the continuing interaction between law and medicine problems arising from this interaction have been addressed in part by previous volumes in this series in fact one such problem constitutes the central focus of volume 5 mental illness law and public policy 1 the present volume joins other volumes in this series in offering an exploration and critical analysis of concepts and values underlying health care in this volume however we look as well at some of the general questions occasioned by the law's relation with medicine we do so out of a conviction that medicine and the law must be understood as the human creations they are reflecting important wide ranging but often unaddressed aspects of the nature of the human condition it is only by such philosophical analysis of the nature of the conceptual foundations of the health care professions and of the legal profession that we will be able to judge whether these professions do indeed serve our best interests such philosophical explorations are required for the public policy decisions that will be pressed upon us through the increasing complexity of health care and of the law's response to new and changing circumstances as a consequence this volume attends as much to issues in public policy as in the law the law is after all the creature of human decisions concerning prudent public policy and basic human rights and goods

the oratorian priest antonio gallonio 1556 1605 devoted his life to writing about saints the thread running through his hagiographical oeuvre was renunciation of this world humility subservience and endurance yet he engaged with the expertise of lay people jurists physicians and engineers so as to appeal to their interests and convert them in order to emphasize how saints endured torture healed disease and exercised piety rather than ingenuity gallonio ventured into those secular disciplines even if he did not endorse them this book surveys gallonio's published and unpublished works and his position in roman society to expose the tensions between a theocratic clergy and the self assertion of skilled and scholarly professionals in the italian counter reformation

the rapidly changing face of modern medicine and the increasing involvement of public debate in its practice are reflected in the wide range of contributions to this book which takes

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who should define what constitutes ethical and lawful medical practice judges doctors scientists or someone else entirely this volume analyses how effectively criminal law operates as a forum for resolving ethical conflict in the delivery of health care it addresses key questions such as how does criminal law regulate controversial bioethical areas what effect positive or negative does the use of criminal law have when regulating bioethical conflict and can the law accommodate moral controversy by exploring criminal law in theory and in practice and examining the broad field of bioethics as opposed to the narrower terrain of medical ethics it offers balanced arguments that will help readers form reasoned views on the ethical legitimacy of the invocation and use of criminal law to regulate medical and scientific practice and bioethical issues

to date little analysis exists of the criminal process's roles as a regulator of medical practice and as an arbiter of bioethics nor whether criminal law is an appropriate forum for judging ethical medical dilemmas the conscription of criminal law into moral controversy and the perceived rise in criminal investigations of medical errors sets the backdrop for this innovative historical and theoretical analysis of the relationship between medicine bioethics and the criminal process case studies on abortion end of life and the separation of conjoined twins reveal how judges grapple with bioethics in criminal cases and the impact of theatre on the criminal law's response to ethically controversial medical cases a central argument is that bioethics and criminal law are not necessarily incompatible rather it is the theatre surrounding interactions between bioethics and criminal law that often distorts and creates tension

in recent years debates have arisen concerning the encroachment of the criminal process in regulating fatal medical error the implementation of the corporate manslaughter and corporate homicide act 2007 and the recent release of the director of public prosecution's assisted suicide policy consequently questions have been raised regarding the extent to which such intervention helps or if it in fact hinders the sustained development of medical practice in this collection danielle griffiths and andrew sanders explore the operation of the criminal process in healthcare in the uk as well as in other jurisdictions including the usa australia new zealand france and the netherlands using evidence from previous cases alongside empirical data each essay engages the reader with the debate surrounding what the appropriate role of the criminal process in healthcare should be and aims to clarify and shape policy and legislation in this under researched area
