german philosopher friedrich nietzsche was one the most controversial figures of the 19th century his evocative writings on religion morality culture philosophy and science were often polemic attacks against the established views of his time first published in 1887 the genealogy of morals is a work which follows and expands upon the principles of his previous works thus spoke zarathustra and beyond good and evil in a preface and three interrelated essays nietzsche outlines his theories on the origins of our moral prejudices the genealogy of morals was written partly in response to his friend paul rée s book the origin of the moral sensations whose genealogical hypothesis of morality he found unsatisfactory nietzsche begins by reiterating in his first essay the historical conflict between socio economic classes
