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what time is it if you re not excited about the immediate future you ve been listening to the wrong people the question i ask is a spiritual one what time is it according to god s clock it may be one minute before the trump sounds do you know what that means jesus is coming soon the greatest days on earth are ahead for all of us every human on earth it s going to be a panorama production of gigantic supernatural wonders encompassing the time that now is until the millennium and glimpses beyond this production is the coming of the lord such a kaleidoscope production fulfilling all god s grace with the rapture of the church and then his wrath carried over millennia after millennia to the great awesome day of the lord jesus christ only god could plan produce and unfold it will most assuredly amaze and astound you whether a spectator on the fringes looking with fear trembling and wonder or a participant in this full fledged all encompassing production of here to eternity

the overarching theme of this book is that the second coming of jesus happened in ad 72 and that therefore jesus is not coming again to rapture the church the book lays out a thorough exploration in support of this theme daniels prophecies are foundational especially his prophecy of the seventy weeks in dan 9 24 27 and his prophecy of four sequential fertile crescent mediterranean empires see dan 7 the fourth empire or the roman empire is the key to understanding my theme with stress on the meaning of the horns on the head of the fourth beast see dan 7 7 8 as proof of my theme i use the biblical code of two or three witnesses see e g deut 19 15 matt 18 16 john 8 17 and i john 5 8 the three witnesses i give are daniel jesus and the collective apostles all of whom taught and agreed that jesus second coming would take place before jesus generation passed away matt 24 34 furthermore i show how the epistles of the n t reflect this theme by citing scores of passages from them for my readers to consider finally in chapter five of the book and in five appendixes i show how the book of revelation aptly interpreted fully agrees with this theme

his self penned charts often large in size and intricate were printed and circulated separately from the books in which they had been appended as the second coming of christ is one of larkin s shorter works it may be used as an introduction both to his style of writing and to his unique use of charts readers should note that as many of the charts are very large the small print may require use of a magnifying glass to fully absorb the annotations
