this book aims to celebrate the many contributions of professor tommy koh as a singaporean diplomat public intellectual and social changemaker it is an account of the ideas and ideals of an extraordinary singaporean public servant who was not only born with the talent and ability to traverse many areas of society but one who when given the opportunity had the drive and ambition to make the most of it to create a better world for singaporeans and the global community experts in the various fields of endeavour and people who have worked with him examine his significant contributions in essays that are organised in four main sections diplomacy and international relations arts culture and heritage progressive society international law and a fifth section that features tributes contributed by his colleagues and former classmates set in the context of singapore a nation known for its socio economic progress its ability to punch above its own weight in international relations as well as its increasing appreciation for heritage the arts and sustainable development this book illustrates the power of the individual and sense of agency that can create the systems and structures to achieve all those things the story of professor tommy koh as captured in this book should energise other change agents to go out and create the progressive inclusive and sustainable world they want an inspirational collection for general readers this book reflects the spirit of singapore s pioneer generation whose determination and tenacity turned the nation into the modern day miracle that singapore is today

dr wee kim wee was a pioneering singaporean journalist and diplomat with a most improbable rise

and rise in life among his many other accomplishments he helped end a regional war kept one of the world's oldest newspapers alive till today and rescued the presidency of the republic of singapore from a spell in the gutter just as water softens stone he overcame the grimmest odds with his winsome ways and unimpeachable character this meticulously researched book brims with fresh insights about the man most singaporeans claimed as my president they include telling facets from the author's interviews with more than 30 people who knew dr wee best in every decade of his storied life dr wee started out being too poor to complete secondary school to holding singapore's highest office his lightly worn shrewdness and genuine regard for all living things plucked him out of obscurity and thrust him into moments that shook singapore eventually making him a beloved household name dr wee was the embodiment of singapore exceptionalism and this biography is the last word on a sort of man that singapore will rarely if ever encounter again

the thucydides trap and a us china face off are not structurally inevitable us china relations are what the us and china make of them phua focuses on the ability to see us as us and china as china to trigger both countries cultural tendencies towards pragmatism phua examines china's arduous journey to fit in the westphalian system the deep cultural misunderstandings by the west of sunzi's the art of war and attempts to offer an inside out cultural synthesis of classical and modern chinese thought as a proxy of their operational code beyond the standard clichés about confucian and daoist thought he builds on jervis perception and misperception as well as alastair johnston's cultural realism readers will benefit from a culturally chinese western educated and politically neutral understanding of china as china an essential primer for academics practitioners and students of international relations diplomacy and chinese culture

this book examines the south china sea territorial disputes from the perspective of international order the authors argue that both china and the us are attempting to impose their respective preferred orders to the region and that the observed disputes are due to the clash of two competing order building projects ordering the maritime space is essential for these two countries to validate their national identities and to achieve ontological security because both are ontological security seeking states this imperative gives them little room for striking a grand bargain between them the book focuses on how china and the us engage in practices and discourses that build contest and legitimise the two major ordering projects they promote in the region it concludes that

china must act in its legitimization strategy in accordance with contemporary publicly accepted norms and rules to create a legitimate maritime order while the us should support asean in devising a multilateral resolution of the disputes

what is pragmatism is it a means to an end or an end in itself is it antithetical to ideology or morality arguing that pragmatism is a skill much more than an attribute phua examines how viewing it in this way can help achieve better foreign policy outcomes he examines and contrasts the ways in which the united states china and singapore have incorporated pragmatism into their approaches to foreign policy in doing so he debunks dualistic myths around pragmatism and ideology and promotes the view of pragmatism as a skill that can be developed an essential primer for students analysts and policymakers with a fresh and practical approach to pragmatism

this book offers a comprehensive practitioner s guide to negotiating at the united nations although much of the content can be applied broadly the guide focuses on navigating multilateral negotiations at the un the book is a tool to help new un negotiators explaining basic negotiation concepts and offering insight into the complexities of the un system it also offers a playbook for cooperation for negotiators at any level exploring the dynamics of relationships and alliances the art of chairing a negotiation and the importance of balancing the power asymmetries present in any multilateral discussion the book proposes improvements to the un negotiation process and looks at the impact of information technologies on negotiation dynamics it also shares stories from women un delegates illustrating what it means to be a female negotiator at the un this book is an exploration of the power of the individual in any negotiation and of the responsibility all negotiators have in wielding that power to speak for a better world this book will be of much interest to students of diplomacy global governance foreign policy and international relations as well as practitioners and policymakers
