though best known for the red badge of courage his classic novel of men at war in his tragically brief life and career stephen crane produced a wealth of stories among them the monster the upturned face the open boat and the title story that stand among the most acclaimed and enduring in the history of american fiction this superb volume collects stories of unique power and variety in which impressionistic hallucinatory and realistic situations alike are brilliantly conveyed through the cold sometimes brutal irony of crane s narrative voice

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this collection addresses the key american short story writers poe irving melville hawthorne twain crane bierce chopin and james and addresses both the vision and the design of their collective achievement

in many fictional narratives the progression of the plot exists in tension with a very different and powerful dynamic that runs at a hidden and deeper level throughout the text in this volume dan shen systematically investigates how stylistic analysis is indispensable for uncovering this covert progression through rhetorical narrative criticism the book brings to light the covert progressions in works by the american writers edgar allan poe stephan crane and kate chopin and british writer katherine mansfield

in song verse narrative and dramatic form war literature has existed for nearly all of recorded history accounts of war continue to occupy american bestseller lists and the stacks of american libraries this innovative work establishes the american novel of war as its own sub genre within american war literature creating standards by which such works can be classified and critically and popularly analyzed each chapter identifies a defining characteristic analyzes existing criticism and explores the characteristic in american war novels of record topics include violence war rhetoric the death of

noncombatants and terrain as an enemy

in spite of an extensive secondary literature that bristles with philosophical labels concerning his outlook stephen crane s philosophy has been virtually ignored patrick dooley s systematic examination of all crane s writings novels sketches short stories news dispatches and poems whether famous or previously ignored discloses coherent but subtle metaphysical epistemological social and ethical positions dooley provides a sustained direct discussion of crane s philosophy and offers vivid depictions of fundamental philosophical issues

for the first time all 112 of stephen crane s short stories and sketches including several that have not been included in any previous collection and two that are now in print for the first time have been brought together in one volume critics call stephen crane who is best known for his civil war novel the red badge of courage the first modern american writer crane was only twenty eight when he died but his work had a profound influence on american letters he helped to kill sentimentality in american writing giving this country s fiction renewed strength and dignity as an art form crane is considered the american counterpart of such european nationalists as zola tolstoy and flaubert he refused to bow to the conventions of the day or to popular taste but wrote about life as he saw it in the closing years of the nineteenth century and honest vision of life was the foundation stone of his artistic aims and so he sought first hand experiences and personal involvement in his themes he lived the life of the open boat before he wrote the story his stories of war and conflict such as a mystery of heroism and virtue in war reflect his experiences as a war correspondent crane strove for originality in his writing his style tense darting abrupt ironic blends perfectly with an impressionistic technique to give emotional psychological and symbolic significance to a series of astutely observed and richly colored episodes the stories and sketches that were a product of his one man literary revolution are as modern today as ever this collection includes an authoritative introduction by the editor in which he evaluates the artistic significance of crane s work the stories and sketches are presented in chronological order and have been carefully edited to ensure that they are in their original form
