this book explores how china brazil relations have been impacted by the oil related bilateral trade investments infrastructure projects and financing an increasingly consequential aspect of sino brazilian relations which sheds light on china s energy security concerns and its relationship with oil rich countries more generally this book depicts in detail how china s quest for petroleum has been helping brazil become an oil power written by a brazilian career diplomat that completed a phd in mandarin on the topic of this publication and whose insights into chinese economics politics and energy policies are deep this book will interest scholars diplomats economists and professionals in the oil sector

this book examines china s trade insertion strategy in latin america divided into five parts the book features scholars from china chile

costa rica peru and mexico who present the main actors and dynamics around china s trade policy in the region in twelve carefully selected contributions with qualitative and quantitative case studies highlighting china s important trade presence in latin america after joining the world trade organization wto the book analyzes the effects of free trade agreements china signed with three countries in the region chile 2005 peru 2010 and costa rica 2011 as well as specific preferential agreements with other countries from latin america while the first part of this book reviews china and latin america trade policies the second part explores china s view of latin america in a third part of the book the contributions provide a deeper look into the trade relations between china and the countries of peru costa rica mexico and the united states the fourth part of the volume focuses on the emerging trade agenda between the two regions finally the fifth part of the book discusses the trade challenges between china and latin american and caribbean countries the book will appeal to scholars of international relations economics and political science as well as policy makers interested in a chinese and latin american perspective on trade policy in general and on china s trade policy in the region in particular

in developed countries like the us germany and the uk it has been observed that workers who perform non routine activities either cognitive or manual have benefited in terms of employment and income while those performing routinary tasks have seen their job prospects and wages decline this has led to a polarization of the labor markets and to a decrease in certain measures of inequality this phenomenon has been attributed to task biased technological change tbbc which differs from the skilled biased technological change in the fact that not only highly skilled workers have benefited from technology advancement this book presents evidence of how digitalization and task biased technological change are affecting the labor markets of different regions of the world and examines the factors that cause this inequality among nations it examines recent issues around the effect of task biased technological change on labor markets and the economy in general with a comparison of different countries in central and eastern europe north america and latin america as well as in other regions of the world the incorporation of the abovementioned regions presents relevant particularities for the subject matter addressed in the book the book also considers questions such as how labor market effects differ by gender and what the impact of digital skills on employment inequalities and public policies might be in so doing it identifies the advances opportunities and changes that have taken place while also making public policy proposals the main market for the book is the global community of graduate students and researchers in the field of economics and specifically in the study of labor markets
