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brass ensemble originally for trumpet and orchestra canadian brass virtuoso fred mills expertly arranges it here for trumpet solo and brass quintet

one of the best known pieces for solo trumpet is now available for quintet the solo trumpet line is mixed throughout the 2 trumpets and the horn both the trombone and tuba are active with running scalar passages and the horn is given the solo in the second movement the original 4 movement work scored for solo trumpet 2 violins and continuo in d major has been transposed into b flat concert for ease of performance

hummel was appointed the successor to joseph haydn as konzertmeister for the court orchestra of nikolaus ii prince esterhazy in 1803 for the opening concert marking the new appointment which was held on january 1 1804 hummel composed his three movement concerto for trumpet with anton weidinger in mind the same trumpet virtuoso for whom haydn wrote his own famous concerto hummel's concerto was originally in the key of e major and weidinger is believed to have modified some passages to ease performance the piece is most often heard today transposed to e flat major the same as for haydn's concerto as performance is generally easier and considerably more effective in that key this new study score in e flat major is a reduced format version of the newly engraved large score edited by clark mcalister first issued in 2012 by e f kalmus

haydn composed his famous concerto especially for trumpet for his friend anton weidinger 1766 1852 a virtuoso performer who developed a special keyed trumpet which allowed a full chromatic scale weidinger's invention while somewhat successful was ultimately superseded by the valve system used now in the 1830s haydn's concerto was first performed on march 28 1800 in vienna with weidinger as soloist not long after his appointment as imperial royal court and theatre trumpeter the new study score offered here is a reduced size format of the newly engraved and well researched large score prepared in 2010 by clark mcalister

this arrangement uses excerpts of the concerto transposed down to b flat minor to create a solo trumpet feature in a brass quintet setting this concerto s combination of lyricism and virtuosity make it an ideal choice to demonstrate the harmonic richness and melodies of the romantic era while featuring a trumpet soloist

this book presents music titles in which the organ is part of a chamber ensemble alphabetized by composer entries contain the bibliographical information for each title and a brief commentary or description as well as information on the level of difficulty timing mood fingerings pedalings and other performance aids the selections are suitable for concerts and religious services and are written in a variety of styles from baroque to contemporary this catalogue will be of interest to church organists searching for a piece for organ and brass appropriate for easter visiting instrumentalists choosing music for a sunday service teachers introducing their organ students to the experience of accompanying a violin and instrumentalists seeking a composition to play with the organ among many others book jacket title summary field provided by blackwell north america inc all rights reserved

the concerto for tromba in fa trumpet concerto has been rescored from its original concert band instrumentation into this edition for solo trumpet and brass quintet it was written to feature guest trumpet soloist dr karen gustafson with the alaska brass during a recital at the university of alaska fairbanks summer arts academy

this concerto by johann valentin rathgeber was originally written for two trumpets and strings this work is not unlike the double trumpet concerto of vivaldi with the two outer movements full of imitation and rhythmic interest the key has been transposed from eb to bb concert

the bibliography lists nearly 5 000 compositions by 200 composers of jazz and art music indicating where scores or realizations can be purchased rented or borrowed and which boston area libraries have them in their collections

this is the beautiful slow movement from the famous trumpet concerto by telemann in this movement the oboes replaced here by trumpets play an elegant duet over a simple wandering continuo line this is a da capo aria in which the d c has been written out with some ornaments this is a great piece that would work well at a church or wedding service as well as on a concert

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
