university of california los angeles a south african by birth he was one of the first writers on genocide as well as other aspects of african studies and urban sociology his major book genocide penguin 1981 remains in print the leo kuper foundation is a non governmental organization dedicated to the eradication of genocide through research advice and education it was created in washington dc in 1994 following the death of leo kuper with the aim of improving measures to prevent genocide the main area of work for the past five years has been in support of the creation of an international criminal court troy duster is director at the institute for the history of the production of knowledge new york university
