against the fire ended another battle for the future of the city erupted between its entrenched business establishment and its poor and immigrant laborers and shopkeepers an enrapturing account of the fire s inexorable march and an eye opening look at its aftermath the burning of the world tells the story of one of the most infamous calamities in history and the new chicago it precipitated a disaster that still shapes american cities to this day
