by storm for the first time jazz became fashionable people crowded into reisenwehr s
restaurant where they played they were in constant demand for shows and charity
performances they accompanied sophie tucker and appeared on the same bill as caruso in
march 1917 they made the first jazz record and their fame flew across the whole continent
the record was the biggest seller in the r c a catalogue passing the magic million and easily
outstripping the records of caruso and sousa s band which were the current popular idols
