the expertly written text offers an insight into the private and public life of the heir to the throne of England from his early years at Buckingham Palace through to his education at Gordonstoun and Trinity College Cambridge as well as his time in the Royal Navy with a wide range of humanitarian and social interests Charles is patron to a number of charities and organisations including the Prince's Trust founded in 1976 he has played a central role as father to Princes William and Harry and his devotion and dedication to his mother Queen Elizabeth II is outstanding this beautifully illustrated biography is part of the Pitkin Royal Collection series celebrating the lives of the British Royal Family other notable titles in this insightful series include Royal Babies the Queen and her family and Queen Elizabeth II

the controversial Netflix series *The Crown* covers the tumultuous period from the Queen's accession in 1952 to the present day and so does this book which explores the rise decline and to some unexpected rebound of the historic UK Canada Australia and New Zealand alliance while a post-Brexit and post-Elizabethan Britain seeks a new role in today's volatile world its traditional partner countries also recognise the logic of reinvigorating their relationship based on a multitude of still strong cultural economic political and military ties including the monarchy as a uniquely shared global and not merely British institution but this wasn't always the case although in the 1950s commentators spoke of a new Elizabethan age with much postwar hope across the Commonwealth that optimism quickly faded by the 1970s many thought Britain washed up and that Crown and Commonwealth ties and allegiance were becoming obsolete perhaps unsurprisingly the four countries increasingly went their separate ways so a groggy time traveller from that period appearing in London Toronto Sydney or Auckland today would be taken by surprise by the durability of the Crown even as it has passed to King Charles and the growing reconvergence of the four CAnZUK realms in terms of trade defence foreign policy coordination freedom of movement mutual recognition of professional qualifications and other new or revived links this book evocatively tells the whole story of where we are what's possible for the future and not least how we got here in today's age of global instability and raw power politics this renewed Anglosphere Crown Commonwealth alliance is more important and relevant than ever

from the new york times bestselling author and master of narrative nonfiction comes the tragic story of charles i his warrior queen britain s civil wars and the trial for his life less than forty years after england s golden age under elizabeth i the country was at war with itself split between loyalty to the crown or to parliament war raged on english soil the english civil war would set family against family friend against friend and its casualties were immense a greater proportion of the population died than in world war i at the head of the disintegrating kingdom was king charles i in this vivid portrait informed by previously unseen manuscripts including royal correspondence between the king and his queen leanda de lisle depicts a man who was principled and brave but fatally blinkered charles never understood his own subjects or court intrigue at the heart of the drama were the janus faced cousins who befriended and betrayed him henry holland his peacocking servant whose brother the new england colonialist robert warwick engineered the king s fall and lucy carlisle the magnetic last boleyne girl and faithless favorite of charles s maligned and fearless queen the tragedy of charles i was that he fell not as a consequence of vice or wickedness but of his human flaws and misjudgments the white king is a story for our times of populist politicians and religious war of manipulative media and the reshaping of nations for charles it ended on the scaffold condemned as a traitor and murderer yet lauded also as a martyr his reign destined to sow the seeds of democracy in britain and the new world
