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with a few notable exceptions historians have tended to ignore the role that science and medicine played in the antebellum south the fourteen essays in science and medicine in the old south help to redress that neglect by considering scientific and medical developments in the early nineteenth century south and by showing the ways in which the south s scientific and medical activities differed from those of other regions the book is divided into two sections the essays in the first section examine the broad background of science in the south between 1830 and 1860 the second section addresses medicine specifically the essays frequently counterpoint each other in the first section ronald numbers and janet numbers argue that he south s failure to keep pace with the north in scientific areas resulted from demographic factors william scarborough asserts that slavery produced a social structure that encouraged agricultural and political careers rather than scientific and industrial ones charles dew offers a strong indictment of slavery suggesting that the conservative influence of the institution severely discouraged the adoption of modern technologies other essays examine institutions of higher learning in the south southern scientific societies and the relationship between science and theology

the section on medicine in the old south also examines the ways in which the medical needs and practices of the old south were both similar to and distinct from those of other regions k david patterson argues that slavery in effect imported african diseases into the southeast and created a modified west african disease environment james h cassedy points out that land management policies determined by slavery land clearing soil exhaustion also helped created a distinctive disease environment other contributors discuss southern public health problems domestic medicine slave folk beliefs and the special medical needs of blacks science and medicine in the old south is a long overdue examination of these segments of the southern cultural milieu these essays will do much to clarify misconceptions about the time and the region moreover they suggest directions for future research

during the twentieth century medicine has been radically transformed and powerfully transformative in 1900 western

medicine was important to philanthropy and public health but it was marginal to the state the industrial economy and the welfare of most individuals it is now central to these aspects of life our prospects seem increasingly dependent on the progress of bio medical sciences and genetic technologies which promise to reshape future generations the editors of medicine in the twentieth century have commissioned over forty authoritative essays written by historical specialists but intended for general audiences some concentrate on the political economy of medicine and health as it changed from period to period and varied between countries others focus on understandings of the body and a third set of essays explores transformations in some of the theatres of medicine and the changing experiences of different categories of practitioners and patients

little attention has been paid to the history of the influence of the social sciences upon medical thinking and practice in the twentieth century the essays in this volume explore the consequences of the interaction between medicine and social science by evaluating its significance for the moral and aterial role of medicine in modern societies some of the essays examine the ideas of both clinicians and social scientists who believed that highly technologized medicine could be made more humanistic by understanding the social relations of health and illness other authors interrogate the critical assault which social science has made upon medicine as a system of knowledge organisation and power the volume discusses therefore the relationship between social scientific knowledge both inand ofmedicine in the twentieth century collectively the essays illustrate that the respective power of biology and culture in determining human behaviour and social transition continues to be an unresolved paradox

this book discusses asian medicine which puts enormous emphasis on prevention and preservation of health and examines how in recent decades medical schools in asia have been increasingly shifting toward a curative approach it offers an ethnographic investigation of the scenarios in china and india and finds that modern students and graduates in these countries perceive asian medicine to be as important as western medicine there is a growing tendency to integrate asian medicine with western medical thought in the academic curriculum that has led to a gradual decline of asian

medical thought and practices at the same time there has been a massive rise in patent drugs health products and cosmetics being sold under the brand names of asian medicine or herbal medicine most of these drugs and health products do not follow the classical formulas found in the asian medical texts the book analyses these texts and concludes that contemporary asian medicine rarely follows the classical texts and in fact uses asian medicine brands to sell western health products and practices with a particular focus on the formal and professional sector of chinese herbal medicine and indian ayurvedic medicine in urban areas this book appeals to a broad readership including undergraduate students and academics as well as non experts md nazrul islam is an associate professor in the general education office united international college beijing normal university hong kong baptist university he was a visiting associate professor in the school of population and public health university of british columbia 2015 16 during which time he completed this book manuscript

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
