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first published in 1987 new york times bestseller i m with the band has been reprinted throughout the years all over the world this is the stylish exuberant and sweetly innocent tale of one of the most famous groupies of the 1960s and 70s beginning with pamela des barres early obsession with elvis her own beatlemania madness and her fierce determination to meet the musicians who rocked her world i m with the band illuminates the glory days of scintillating encounters with musical gods including jim morrison jimi hendrix mick jagger and keith moon a girl just wanting to have fun des barres immersed herself in the drugs danger and ecstasy of the freewheeling 1960s as a member of the gtos girls together outrageously an all female group masterminded by frank zappa des barres was in the thick of the most revolutionary renaissance in the history of modern popular music she travelled with led zeppelin lived in sin with don johnson turned down a date with elvis presley and was close friends with robert plant gram parsons and ray davies she had affairs with mick jagger jimmy page keith moon waylon jennings chris hillman noel redding and jim morrison among others a woman in possession of her own destiny des barres blazed a trail for women s life writing standing up for female voices and experience everywhere from original diaries told with great warmth chutzpah and joie de vivre this is a frank memoir that wears its heart on its sleeve and recalls one of rock n roll s most thrilling eras this edition contains new material from the author including her response to the vitriolic shaming of groupies and a foreword by roisin o connor rock journalist and music correspondent for the independent

rolling stone magazine recently released its list of the 100 greatest albums in rock music history a period spanning more than fifty years nearly 60 percent of those albums were released in the decade from 1965 to 1975 the golden age of classic rock this book is a wide ranging portrait of that transformative and remarkable time from the dawn of the singer songwriter era to days before disco this book is presented in a question and answer format but it is hardly a trivia book it covers such diverse topics as censorship chart phenomena album covers rock groupies manufactured bands one hit wonders rock festivals supergroups novelty songs and the beatles all of the major figures of the 60s and 70s are here cream ccr jimi hendrix joni mitchell simon and garfunkel the who the rolling stones led zeppelin bruce springsteen queen neil young the eagles the allman brothers lynnyrd skynyrd stevie wonder elton john linda ronstadt pink floyd billy joel marvin gaye david bowie james taylor carole king aretha franklin lou reed carly simon laura nyro and many others exhaustively researched so you think you know rock and roll is filled with i never knew that moments on every page

in this authoritative unsparing history of the biggest rock group of the 1970s spitz delivers inside details and analysis with his well known gift for storytelling people from the author of the iconic bestselling history of the beatles the definitive account of arguably the greatest rock band of all time rock star whatever that term means to you chances are it owes a debt to led zeppelin no one before or since has lived the dream quite like jimmy page robert plant john paul jones and john bonham in led zeppelin bob spitz takes their full measure separating myth from reality with his trademark connoisseurship and storytelling flair from the opening notes of their first album the band announced itself as something different a collision of grand artistic ambition and brute primal force of english folk music and african american blues spitz s account of their artistic journey amid the fascinating ecosystem of popular music is irresistible but the music is only part of the legend led zeppelin is also the story of how the sixties became the seventies of how innocence became decadence of how rock took over led zeppelin wasn t the first band to let loose on the road but as with everything else they took it to an entirely new level not all the legends are true but in spitz s careful accounting what is true is astonishing and sometimes disturbing led zeppelin gave no quarter and neither has bob spitz led zeppelin is the long awaited full reckoning the band richly deserves

when cy flood applied for work as a holiday rep his reasons were simple he wanted to party like crazy booze like there was no tomorrow and pull like it was going out of fashion in this book cy paints a shockingly true picture of life as a travel rep a world of violent crime corruption and drug dealing

helm lays it all bare in vivid impassioned prose adding an earthly backwoods tone that makes the book read like a southern novel like thomas wolfe writing about rock n roll boston globe one of the most insightful and intelligent rock bios in recent memory entertainment weekly the band who backed bob dylan when he went electric in 1965 and then turned out a half dozen albums of beautifully crafted image rich songs is now regarded as one of the most influential rock groups of the 60s but while their music evoked a southern mythology only their arkansawyer drummer levon helm was the genuine article from the cotton fields to woodstock from seeing sonny boy williamson and elvis presley to playing for president clinton this wheel s on fire replays the tumultuous history of our times in levon s own

unforgettable folksy drawl this edition is expanded with a new epilogue covering the last dozen years of levon s life levon helm 1940 2012 met ronnie hawkins at the age of 17 and formed what would soon become the band he maintained a successful career as a singer and actor until his death stephen davis is the author of hammer of the gods the led zeppelin saga more room in a broken heart the true adventures of carly simon old gods almost dead the 40 year odyssey of the rolling stones jim morrison life death legend walk this way the autobiography of aerosmith and others
