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american literature is no longer the refuge of the solitary hero like the society it mirrors it is now a far richer many faceted explication of a complicated and diverse society racially culturally and ethnically interwoven and at the same time fractured and fractious ten women writing fiction in america today toni cade bambara joan didion louise erdrich gail godwin mary gordon alison lurie joyce carol oates jayne anne phillips susan fromberg schaeffer and mary lee settle represent that geographic ethnic and racial diversity that is distinctively american their differing perspectives on literature and the american experience have produced erdrich's stolid north dakota plainswomen didion's sun baked

dreamers and screamers the urban ethnics irish jewish and black of gordon schaeffer and bambara oates s small town often violent neurotics lurie s intellectual sophisticates and the southern survivors and victims male and female of phillips settle and godwin the ten original essays in this collection focus on the traditional themes of identity memory family and enclosure that pervade the fiction of these writers the fictional women who emerge here as these critics show are often caught in the interwoven strands of memory perceive literal and emotional space as entrapping find identity elusive and frustrating and experience the interweaving of silence solitude and family in complex patterns each essay in this collection is followed by bibliographies of works by and about the writer in question that will be invaluable resources for scholars and general readers alike here is a readable critical discussion of ten important contemporary novelists who have broadened the pages of american literature to reflect more clearly the people we are

though he never reached the lead actor status he labored so relentlessly to achieve warren oates 1928 1982 is one of the most memorable and skilled character actors of the 1970s with his rugged looks and measured demeanor oates crafted complex characters who were at once brazen and thoughtful wild and subdued friends remember the hard living hard drinking actor as kind and caring but also sometimes as mean as a blue eyed devil married four times partial to road trips in his rv affectionately known as the roach coach and famous for performances for directors ranging from sam peckinpah to steven spielberg warren oates remained a hollywood outsider perfectly suited to the 1960s and 1970s counterculture born in the small town of depoy in rural western kentucky and reared in louisville oates began his career in the late 1950s with bit parts in television westerns though hardly lucrative work it was during this time oates met renegade director sam peckinpah establishing the creative relationship and destructive friendship that produced some of oates s most unforgettable roles in ride the high country 1962 major dundee 1965 and the wild bunch 1969 as well as a leading part in bring me the head of alfredo garcia 1974 though oates maintained a close association with peckinpah he had a penchant for working with a variety of visionary directors who understood his approach and were eager to enlist the subtle talents of the consummate character actor with supporting roles in in the heat of the night 1967 the hired hand 1971 badlands 1973 1941 1979 and stripes 1981 oates delivered solid performances for filmmakers as diverse and talented as norman jewison peter fonda terrence malick steven spielberg and ivan reitman oates s offscreen personality was just as complex as his on screen persona notorious for being a nightlife reveler he was as sensitive and introspective as he was outgoing and prone to periods of exuberant and at times illegal excess though he never became a marquee name warren oates continues to influence actors like billy bob thornton and benicio del toro as well as directors such as quentin tarantino and richard linklater all of whom have cited oates as a major inspiration in warren oates a wild life author susan compo skillfully captures the story of oates s eventful life indulgent lifestyle and influential career

from august 28 to august 30 1862 union and confederate armies fought for the second time on the manassas virginia battlefield the battle of second manassas or second bull run was the culmination of general robert e lee s campaign after the seven days to shift the fighting from the vicinity of richmond to northern virginia lee s victory placed him in a position to carry the war north of the potomac river and set the stage for the maryland campaign of 1862 summer lightning is a battlefield guide that sequentially follows the fighting from brawner s farm on august 28 to the final confederate attacks against union positions at henry hill on august 30 summer lightning uses a series of twenty stops with multiple positions to guide the reader through the battlefield and to positions and routes used by both armies thus providing a you are there view of the engagement with easy to follow directions detailed tactical maps extensive eyewitness accounts and editorial analysis the reader is transported to the center of the action a detailed order of battle for both armies is provided as well as information on important sites away from the main battlefield

we as adults are reflected in our children those in our literature as well as those in our families and so it is natural to want to examine their presence among us children and child speech are important literary elements which merit careful critical analysis surprisingly comprehensive studies of the child in american fiction have not been previously attempted and fictional child speech even that of individual characters has been almost totally ignored nevertheless the language of fictional children warrants attention for several reasons first language and language acquisition are primary issues for children much as sexual development is primary issues for adolescents second because vast linguistic efforts have been directed toward language acquisition research a broad base of concrete information exists with which to explore the topic and third language is a key which opens many doors an understanding of fictional children s language leads to discoveries about various critical questions sociological and psychological as well as textual and stylistic this study examines the presentation of children and child language in american fiction by applying general linguistic principles as well as specific findings from child language acquisition research to children s speech in literary texts it clarifies sorts and assesses the representations of child speech in american fiction it tests on fictional discourse linguistic concepts heretofore applied exclusively to naturally occurring child language the aim is not to evaluate the degree of realism in writers presentations of child language for that would be a simplistic and reductive enterprise rather the overall object is to analyze fictional child language using linguistic methods
