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understanding the spirit is a precious resource that is a necessity for everyone desiring an intimate relationship with god understanding the spirit will enlighten the mind of the bible theologian as well as explain the intricacies of the spirit of god to the bible novice the spirit of god is amazing wonderful remarkable astonishing and marvelous and those that understand the spirit fully have an awesome opportunity they are able to find peace in times of trouble they

can glorify god when everything in their lives seems to be falling apart they have the assurance in understanding that weeping may endure for a night but joy cometh in the morning when you understand the spirit how the spirit operates and the importance of your relationship with the spirit of god then you are able to walk in this life by faith and not by sight

where is god is god real these have been the cries of humankind since time began searching for the answer involves exploring what is profoundly human which is to be found in the figure of christ that is why we cannot think of god without turning our minds to jesus enzo bianchi helps us find god in stories from the old testament stories of abraham jacob and moose it is the divine within us who really poses the question god where are you when we truly begin to search for god we discover that not only is god real but he is already looking for us enzo bianchi founded the ecumenical monastic bose community in italy in 1965 in the fervor of renewal of the second vatican council he is still the community's prior he is also the author of echoes of the word in this remarkable little volume enzo bianchi's meditation on the elijah story is absolutely captivating god where are you is the work of a christian who loves the old testament and demonstrates how it can speak to us today it should be read very slowly and reflectively and would make excellent lenten reading nicholas king sj the tablet enzo bianchi is one of the most significant christian voices in europe his is a perspective that the english speaking christian world should welcome enthusiastically rowan williams master of magdalene college cambridge

anger bitterness relational issues despair and fear are coming from those who are not paying attention to the battle will be deceived in the fight god has given us his weapons to fight this spiritual war in the armor of god the battle is real the victory is sure you will discover that putting on the armor of god is putting on jesus satan is a liar and a deceiver and he is well trained in lies and deceit being clothed in god s armor keeps the battle where it belongs in the hands of our powerful god we can t fight a spiritual war with emotions or the flesh or we will quickly become casualties we must let our enemy know that we choose to stand our ground against his onslaught and to walk in christ s victory every day

within these pages we find forty nine meditations on the holy spirit that are born of reflection on a wide variety of scripture passages from both the old and new testament from genesis to revelation the author s vast pastoral experience permeates his words as he reminds us that the spirit dwells within each of us his meaningful and insightful exploration of scripture gently invites us to meditate on the word to realize how the working of the spirit is intricately woven into the fabric of our everyday lives and to pray with the spirit who is ever present to us although readers may find this book to be a worthy companion particularly during the seven weeks between easter and pentecost these meditations insights and prayers can be used with great benefit at any time as the spirit moves the fruit of the spirit is offered for all who wish to deepen their spiritual life

we all know how easy it is to lose concentration and let our attention wander it happens so easily and far too frequently this problem of inattentiveness this also happens in the spiritual life god speaks to us but we fail to recognise his voice our minds are elsewhere we are not attuned to his whisper he wants to lead us and guide us but we miss his gentle promptings he is present all around us yet we don't register his nearness this robs us of a greater depth in our relationship with him the purpose of this book is to help you become more consistently aware of god to train your ear to hear his voice and your eye to see what he is doing to grow and improve so you can serve god more effectively tony horsfall in his introduction
