this study explores differences in how multiracial versus monoracial families do family differently following devault 2000 doing family denotes a process that forms or maintains family boundaries whereby members are symbolized as a family unit using a snowball sample of twelve multiracial families and twelve monoracial families eighteen interviews and six observations uncovered several factors in how the multiracial families do family differently findings indicate that multiracial families who have members who appear to be racially dissimilar from each other experience either invisibility or are othered invisibility occurs when family members relationships are not recognized by outsiders because of the racial differences of family members when the family is invisible more effort is needed to do family in order to become visible parents use

gestures and physical contact with other family members as well as verbal indications to signal outsiders of the familiar relation being othered occurs when the family relationships are recognized but outsiders express degrees of disapproval of the racial differences among family members appearances families redo family to counter the negativity expressed by outsiders gender and social class play into how the multiracial families are seen and treated the women in multiracial families reported experiencing more invisibility and harsh treatment due to their family affiliations age and outsiders perceptions of their class status than their male counterparts although researchers use a social constructionist view of race the color line is still seen as something that divides multiracial families placing some members on one side and some on the other side of the line by re conceptualizing the color line as a spectrum with white at one end with shades of brown falling along the color line and with black at the other end researchers may design studies that yield a fuller understanding of how family interaction and parenting are influenced by such things as skin tone this research has shown there are occasions where education can enlighten individuals who may or may not intentionally display racist tendencies further research is needed in order to understand how education can change how individuals view the intersection of family and race
