the historical range of the texas horned lizard phrynosoma cornutum spans most of texas and some surrounding states however the species has experienced range contraction and population declines throughout much of the range there is no substantial evidence to specify a single cause so it is likely the decline has been triggered by multiple factors possible threats include red imported fire ants solenopsis invicta herbicides and pesticides habitat destruction and disturbance and collection for the pet trade greater conservation effort is needed for texas horned lizards requiring more detailed knowledge of their habitat requirements the habitat description given by many researchers is vague such as that from burrow et al 2001 a mosaic of bare ground herbaceous vegetation and woody vegetation in close proximity i used radiotelemetry to examine the survival movement and fine scale habitat selection of 23 individual horned lizards released at a reintroduction site in central texas the results of my study indicate an early drop in survival within the first few days post release followed by a relatively gradual decline in survival over the next 60 90 days only one of the 23 lizards successfully entered hibernation in the fall of the 23 lizards nine were predated especially shortly after release by snakes and raccoons eight lizards had an undetermined fate because their radio signals were lost daily movements were short mean 14 49 m sd 21 52 m and home range sizes decreased when the initial locations post release were removed indicating lizards dispersed before settling into a home range my study revealed that texas horned lizards used habitat in similar proportion to what was available on the landscape but chose locations based on thermoregulatory needs and distance to harvester ant colonies overall reintroduction efforts for texas horned lizards might prove successful because the lizards tend to stay close to the release site and exhibit relatively normal behavior however methods to increase

survival such as predator removal and initial release of more lizards should be used to ensure greater success

the texas horned lizard phrynosoma cornutum is a threatened species due to widespread habitat loss urbanization and the decline of their primary prey harvester ants pogonomyrmex sp these ants experience declining populations due to overuse of pesticides and the spread of red imported fire ants solenopsis invicta with its primary prey source in decline these lizards may supplement their diet with a variety of beetles as a small but consistent part of their diet we determined the diversity of available prey by setting pitfall traps in a known texas horned lizard habitat in north texas we determined diet composition by dissecting texas horned lizard fecal samples found in the study site we then compared digestive efficiency of horned lizards fed only harvester ants only beetles only mealworms and only roaches using bomb calorimetry although many potential prey items were available only harvester ants and beetles were constantly found in fecal samples harvester ants made up over 70 of the diet by number of individuals but remnants of small beetles were found in most samples although they make up most of the lizards diet they are unable to digest ants efficiently 30 the digestive efficiency with beetles was variable but somewhat higher mealworms and roach nymph digestive efficiency were significantly higher than an ant or beetle diet therefore the lizards may be selecting beetles to negate nutritional deficits that may result from an all ant diet the high digestive efficiency of mealworms and roach nymphs may allow zoo herpetoculturists to use alternative non ant prey items in the meal plans of texas horned lizards to be more cost effective

the texas horned lizard phrynosoma cornutum is classified as a threatened species they are known by the horns on their head and as the state reptile of texas this flat bodied and fierce looking lizard is important to our ecosystem by limiting the ant population but is falling prey to larger predators such as coyotes and rattlesnakes to further conserve the species and study the population size a team of researchers went to west texas to capture and mark lizards with electronic passive integrated transponder pit tags they had an encounter number of 164 from 2010 2021 the data consisted of gps coordinates sex gravid snout vent length total length weight temperature and route data the data was run through the mark program to show the estimated population size and promote steps to preserve the diversity of the species the findings show that the species has a healthy population in roby texas due to conservation and rehabilitation efforts

i conducted a three year study to evaluate the feasibility of reintroduction of texas horned lizards phrynosoma cornutum a state threatened species in texas that appears to be declining throughout its distribution lizards were translocated from natural populations in western texas to the megillivray and leona mekie muse wildlife management area mwma in the cross timbers of central texas an ecoregion that has experienced apparent local extirpations of horned lizards the management area has been owned and operated by the texas parks wildlife department since 2006 and has undergone extensive horned lizard habitat restoration throughout the area lizards were moved to the management area following a restoration project directed at improving a section of the mwma for texas horned lizards through brush removal after a ten day acclimation period and soft release i tracked horned lizards to evaluate daily movements spatial use sources of mortality reproduction as well as monitor body condition daily movement averages and total area use of individuals were similar to those recorded for wild individuals with peaks in movement

occurring between may and june survivorship was also similar to that reported from wild populations although there was a notable decline in survivorship across the three active seasons although i observed reproduction each year and body condition of lizards remained mostly stable mortality of translocated lizards was high and may ultimately hinder success of reintroduction projects that are not adequately designed
