her father was an american serviceman her mother a young korean woman confused by the ravages of war abandoned at age four nameless homeless and utterly alone this child of destiny roamed the bleak war ravaged countryside of south korea for three years and was finally left for dead but god had other plans

an orphaned chinese immigrant living in the philippines henry moved alone with just one suitcase to the united states to pursue higher education and the american dream upon completing his masters in electrical engineering at uc berkeley henry was hired by the renowned telecommunications research institute bell laboratories with his newfound success he and his new bride fulfilled his childhood dream of traveling the world visiting the taj mahal the great pyramids and the hanging

gardens of babylon among other wonders of the world henry s later accomplishments with at t and other wireless telecommunication companies provided once unimaginable opportunities after successfully raising his family henry and his wife still enjoy travel and for over thirty years make an annual return to paradise in their favorite destination the island of maui surrounded as often as possible by his family in their seaside home in newburyport massachusetts henry soaks in the lifetime of success and happiness made possible through the early and steadfast determination of his youth now he spends time passing along that wisdom to his five grandchildren

unique in its coverage of contemporary american children s literature this timely single volume reference covers the books our children are or should be reading now from board books to young adult novels enriched with dozens of color illustrations and the voices of authors and illustrators themselves it is a cornucopia of delight 23 color 153 b w illustrations

voices of the lost children of greece is a collection of essays from greek born adoptees in the 1950s after two consecutive wars that ravaged the country never before has this group of adoptees come together to write their stories and share their closely held feelings while many of the adoptees have similar experiences and while they may share some common thoughts about their adoptions their stories are vastly different some harrowing others remarkable the collection will illustrate the impact of adoption itself over years no matter if children were displaced from their parents and country as infants or as youngsters the book will shed light on adoption from many disciplinary angles including sociological psychological and anthropological it will also put these adoptions into a larger historical context the book is further enhanced by greek born adoptee academic poet and writer dr andrew mossin who writes the foreword by dr gonda van steen a preeminent modern greek scholar who pens the first chapter about the history of such adoptions and in the final chapter by dr eirini papadaki who has written extensively about the women of greece and adoption to bring readers a current assessment of adoption practices in greece today

single volume edition of time for poetry time for fairy tales and time for true tales

a classic canadian story of the bravery and ingenuity of three animals who find their way home first published in 1961 the incredible journey tells the story of three pets a young labrador retriever an old bull terrier and a siamese cat while their owners are away in england they are being cared for by a family friend at his home in the country but a miscommunication occurs between the friend and his housekeeper when he goes on a hunting trip and the animals are left alone for a several hours with a gnawing instinct that something has gone wrong they soon set off on a journey to find home which instinct tells them is to the west they travel 400 kilometres across the northern ontario wilderness facing many obstacles along the way swift flowing rivers and the rugged landscape wild animals and unsympathetic humans starvation injuries and sheer exhaustion separately they would not have survived but together this disparate group prevails and they find their way home to the family they love

unlike an anthology of children s literature which includes only chapters or summaries this outstanding seventh edition teaches how to make appropriate judgments about what constitutes quality children s literature using the critical standards for all literature explanations are supplemented by special issues in judging books for children taking readers through the definitions of literary terms by reviewing plot character theme setting point of view style and tone and including special sections on censorship and the importance of reading aloud lukens provides sound criteria for assessing the merit of children s books the book also includes chapters on

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
