since the 1970s the corrections system has experienced exponential growth over the past four decades the number of inmates held in us prisons and jails has quadrupled this massive growth is associated with a number of different issues and challenges within prisons and jails including overcrowding gang activity and misconduct a shift away from rehabilitation and programming expanded use of solitary confinement inmates human rights criticisms of health care and massive publicly funded budgets many states now spend more on corrections than on higher education this book explores these issues in depth it takes current topics in institutional corrections and explores the main issues surrounding each themes include institutional corrections prison behavior including gangs and misconduct solitary confinement prison programming and rehabilitation

american prisons and jails are overflowing with inmates to relieve the pressure courts have imposed fines on overcrowded facilities and fiscally strapped governments have been forced to release numerous prisoners prematurely in this study noted criminologist charles logan makes the case for commercial operation of prisons and jails as an

alternative to the government's monopoly on philosophical economic legal and practical grounds logan argues a compelling case for the private and commercial operation of prisons he critically examines all objections raised by opponents and concludes that while private prisons face many potential problems they do so primarily because they are prisons not because they are private historically the record of private ownership and operation of corrections facilities has been bleak ridden with political corruption physical abuse of prisoners and the single minded pursuit of profits this study demonstrates that this need not be the case critiquing the tendency to contrast private prisons with a hypothetical ideal logan instead compares them with existing public institutions arguing that the potential problems attributed to private prisons are experienced by their public counterparts the work examines ten sets of issues including the propriety cost security and quantity of prisons to set out a strong case for the viability of proprietary prisons

offering perspectives from a range of experts both academic and nonacademic this reference book examines the development of prisons in the united states and addresses the principal contemporary issues and controversies of our prisons and prison systems prisons were initially created as a means of reforming offenders but over time the objective of rehabilitation gave way to a strategy of mass imprisonment a system that has resulted in correctional facilities dealing with serious problems such as overcrowding prison gangs pervasive violence and a significant incidence of mental illness among inmates prisons in the united states a reference handbook examines the history of corrections in america detailing how well intentioned policies intended to get tough on crime sanctioned the dismantling of parole systems and resulted in laws that imposed mandatory minimum sentences these

changes contributed to the united states now having the biggest incarcerated population worldwide and the highest rate of incarceration the book offers an accessible history of the development of the prison system in the united states and analyzes the various problems and controversies associated with prisons in the present day the coverage includes key related issues including those of race and gender and enables readers to understand how past developments continue to affect public and official perceptions of the prison experience for example how the practice of keeping inmates in solitary confinement for lengthy periods has been reinvented and represents a return to a historically discredited practice accounts of former inmates and of correctional officers are integrated into the text adding context and offering rarely heard perspectives on difficult issues affecting prisons

the readings in this collection place the major problems of contemporary american corrections in an appropriate historical and theoretical context providing an overview of the social psychological and political forces that created them and make them extraordinarily difficult to solve

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
