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in the united states an estimated 60 percent of library workers do not hold so called professional positions variously called clerks assistants specialists technicians aides and mini librarians these paraprofessionals are the foundation for library services in many communities they provide vital services including many tasks generally associated with professional librarians that allow libraries to function efficiently and effectively despite the importance of the support staff little attention

has been given to the challenges they face on a daily basis the issues these frontline employees encounter are often similar to those of their professional colleagues but also include such concerns as extremely low pay harsher working conditions and less opportunity for advancement this work first examines the history of the paraprofessional in librarianship and then explores the most common problems faced by support staff

paraprofessional educators entered us schools amidst the struggles of the late 1960s immersed in the crisis of care in public education paras improved systems of education and social welfare despite low pay and second rate status understanding paras as key players in black and latino struggles for jobs and freedom nick juravich details how the first generation of paras in new york city transformed work in public schools and the relationships between schools and the communities they served paraprofessional programs created hundreds of thousands of jobs in working class black and latino neighborhoods these programs became an important pipeline for the training of black and latino teachers in the 1970s and early 1980s while paras organizing helped drive the expansion and integration of public sector unions an engaging portrait of an invisible profession para power examines the lives and practices of the first generation of paraprofessional educators against the backdrop of struggles for justice equality and self determination

overwhelming throughout their careers the authors made mistakes and this book with its short chapters and conversational tone provides insight into decision making and relationship building included are tips like face to face interactions and classroom visitations are essential in assisting staff students and building principals and topics such as the importance of parents in the process the significance of confidentiality due process program development and working with advocates this book is a critical tool in the special education administrator s box and provides practical and friendly advice for a difficult job

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
