the second book of enoch was originally written in greek at alexandria although some parts of the text were written in hebrew in palestine it is dated to the 1st century prior to the destruction of the temple in 70 ce two angels take enoch into six heavens enoch is then taken by gabriel into the seventh heaven and then by michael into the lord s presence this book contains the extended version of 2 enoch the exaltation of melchizedek and is an easy to read translation with notes and cross references to both scripture and

the text known as second enoch was discovered in 1886 by professor sokolov in the archives of the belgrade public library the second book of enoch or 2 enoch was written in the latter half of the first century ad but had gone through alterations and additions to make it more acceptable to the christian community it was written in slavonic but had evidence of being translated from another language 2 enoch has also been known by the title the secrets of enoch 2 enoch and is an expansion of genesis 5 21 32 taking the reader from the time of enoch to the onset of the great flood of noah s day
