our magnificent world of poetry comprising poetic translations from ten languages treasures of international poetry is a unique revelation of the cultural heritage of western civilization as expressed through poetry ranging from the subtle simplicity of sappho to the demanding complexity of pindar or paul valery and from the sacred to the obscene poems written over a period of 3 000 years the anthology includes both major masterpieces and minor poems indicative of important currents in the cultures of europe and the americas from the ancient greece of homer to the twentieth century writers of europe and latin america such as bertolt brecht and pablo neruda it also includes original works by the author that echo the translated poems contemplating mythical subjects and quiet everyday life passionate sensuality and light comedy life and death with a continuous narrative of western cultural heritage s widely diverse poetic expressions this collection exposes anglophone readers to an unprecedented range of poems in other languages enriching their appreciation of poetic wealth and diversity there is much to appeal to any general reader of poetry in treasures of international poetry

the 44th issue of international poetry review ipr appears in a year shaped by change social and political tensions social distancing has frustrated our human need for sociability contact and interaction but has also gifted some of us with time for introspection our peer reviewers and members of the editorial team selected submissions that reflect a vast diversity of experiences voices and tones the poems and translations cover issues such as the passage of time the fragility of life nature the choices we confront and the ones that elude us and the need for social justice and recognition against the backdrop of the transformative events of 2020 2021 this issue underscores the role poetry plays in building communities by structuring ipr around the core principles of empathy solidarity inclusion and accessibility our goal is to become intentional about the capacity of language to enact change the editorial
