Atchity writes in his introduction to this brilliant new study of the poem's structure is the invulnerable shield made for the poem's hero at the Olympian forge of Hephaistos. Atchity's subsequent revelation of the imagery as the guiding aesthetic provides a complete interpretation of the Iliad from the viewpoint of image and theme. The major portion of Atchity's new interpretation is devoted to a comparison of the characters of Helen and Achilles around whom center Atchity shows galaxies of characters and images that can be identified in orderly or disorderly terms, the relationship of which is the theme of the Iliad. In addition, Atchity pays particular attention to the poem's presentation of the art of words, thus making clear the relationship of memory, cognition, and action in the epic tradition.

In a follow-up to his previous Homeric studies, noted classicist Paolo Vivante explores Homer's verse, highlighting rhythm rather than metre. Rhythmical qualities he argues constitute the force of the verse, for example in the way the words take position and in the way each pause hints suspense, producing an immediate sense of time. Vivante's main concern is not with the techniques or rules of the verse composition but more philosophically with verse itself as a fundamental form of human expression. This study will be of interest to both students and scholars.
