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and for us when he will present the church to himself a glorious church not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing but that it should be holy and without blemish eph v 27 in verses 12 15 we have a beautiful description of the garden the land of israel in which his beloved is now planted once more here are found the precious fruits as well as the spikenard and all the trees of frankincense there is the fountain the well of living waters this as well as the north wind and the south wind typifies the holy spirit and she invites him to come to his garden let my beloved come into his garden and eat its precious fruit chapter v the bridegroom answers the invitation extended to him when the bride had said let my beloved come into his not her garden he says i am come into my garden my sister

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
