the story of saul and the woman at endor in 1 samuel 28 lxx 1 kingdoms 28 lay at the center of energetic disputes among early christian authors about the nature and fate of the soul the source of prophetic gifts and biblical truth in addition to providing the original texts and fresh translations of works by origen eustathius of antioch not previously translated into english and six other authors greer and mitchell offer an insightful introduction to and detailed analysis of the rhetorical cast and theological stakes involved in early church debates on this notoriously difficult passage

do the writings of the church fathers support a literalist interpretation of genesis 1 young earth creationists have maintained that they do but are we correctly representing the fathers and their concerns this study from craig allert resets our understanding of early christian interpretation and considers whether contemporary evangelicals may be more bound to modernity in our reading of genesis 1 than we realize

demons in the usa argues that the discourse on the demonic that developed in the nineteenth century continues to exert a powerful hold over the american spiritual imagination the book begins by tracing the conservative christian encounter with spiritualism in the nineteenth century and the mode of thinking about the demonic which developed as spiritualism s core principles reappeared in the new age christian interlocutors once more drew on this anti spiritualist paradigm to condemn the movement this condemnation is absorbed by and amplified through the film the exorcist the author considers how the success of the film disseminates the anti spiritualist paradigm in surprising ways entangling it with entertainment science and politics such that it influences psychology the satanic panic of the 1980s and the contemporary qanon movement this entanglement points to the broader argument of the work while we may wish to think of a film as entertainment and thus having no bearing on reality or demonic material as religious and thus exempt from categories like politics or science the truth is that categories are not so easily separated the author contends that the need to enforce the boundaries of such categories and the failure to do so is a hallmark of the intellectual construct of modernity and that those who believe in demons in the contemporary united states are surprisingly modern in their views the book grounds the importance of media to the twentieth and twenty first century religious experience arguing that the united states of today would not be possible without the exorcist and its products demons in the usa will be of particular interest to scholars dealing with religion in america those with a focus on religion and film or those involved with contemporary demonology

re envisioning theodore is the first comprehensive study of theodore of mopsuestia s biblical interpretation in his catechetical homilies it challenges the common yet reductionist view of theodore s exegetical approach as historical offering a balanced portrayal of this exegete theodore is not a slave of his interpretative methodology and he may omit the exposition of the historical setting of the bible and introduce elements not present in the biblical narrative re envisioning theodore also reveals theodore s previously little known exegetical ties with pro nicenes and through them with origen for the first time this book shows that his exegesis incorporates greco syrian liturgical imagery

spiritual taxonomies and ritual authority recounts how philosophers of the late third century c e organized the spirit world into hierarchies positioning themselves as high priests in the process by establishing themselves as experts on sacred matters they fortified their authority prestige and reputation

this authoritative study explores eustathius of antioch s theological anthropology offering insight into one of the most important thinkers of the early arian controversy sophie cartwright situates eustathius thought in relation to the early arian controversy the constantinian revolution the theological legacies of irenaeus and origen and the philosophical commentary tradition she also locates eustathius within his historical context and provides a detailed overview of the sources for his complex and fragmented corpus eustathius anthropology is indebted to a tradition shaped by the theology of irenaeus that had already come into conversation with origen dr cartwright suggests that origen s own thought was indebted to irenaeus but that he had a radically different cosmology this shaped subsequent engagement with both thinkers eustathius theology of embodiment draws on irenaeus in opposition to what he perceives as the origenist and platonist anthropology which in his anti arian works he associates with eusebius of caesarea however he is deeply indebted to origen for his doctrine of christ s human soul and consequently his wider psychology he places humanity at a great distance from god and seeks to give humanity autonomous value especially in his discourse on god s image this represents one logical negotiation of the rejection of origen s eternal intelligible world eustathius divisive christology offers a picture of christ as the perfect human being that echoes irenaeus adam christ typology fleshed out by an origenian discourse on christ s human soul and infused with a keen awareness of the chasm between god and humankind he proffers a doctrine of inherited sinfulness as an alternative to origen s doctrine of the fall and looks to a corporeal eschatological kingdom ruled over by the human christ this eschatology probably reflects discomfiture with constantine s role in the church
