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Ravensbrück was the only major Nazi concentration camp for women located about fifty miles north of Berlin. The camp was the site of murder by slave labor, torture, starvation, shooting, lethal injection, medical experimentation, and gassing. While this camp was designed to hold 5,000 women, the actual figure was six times this number. Between 1939 and 1945, 132,000 women from twenty-three countries were imprisoned in Ravensbrück, including political prisoners, Jehovah's Witnesses, socialists, including gypsies, prostitutes, and lesbians, criminals, and Jewish women who made up about 20 percent of the population. Only 15,000 survived. Drawing upon more than sixty narratives and interviews of survivors in the United States, Israel, and Europe, as well as unpublished testimonies, documents, and photographs from private archives, Rochelle Saidel provides a vivid collective and individual portrait of Ravensbrück's Jewish women prisoners. She worked for over twenty years to track down these women whose poignant testimonies deserve to be shared with a wider audience and future generations. Their memoirs provide new perspectives and information about satellite camps. There were about 70 slave labor sub camps. Here is the story of real daily camp life with the women's thoughts about food, friendships, fear of rape and sexual abuse, hygiene issues, punishment, work, and resistance. Saidel includes accounts of the women's treatment, their daily struggles to survive, their hopes and fears, their friendships, their survival strategies, and the aftermath. On April 30, 1945, the Soviet Army liberated Ravensbrück. They found only 3,000 extremely ill women in the camp because the Nazis had sent other remaining women on a death march. how did ordinary women like their male counterparts become capable of brutal violence during the holocaust cultural historian elissa mailänder examines the daily work of twenty eight women employed by the ss to oversee prisoners in the concentration and death camp majdanek lublin in poland many female ss overseers in majdanek perpetrated violence and terrorized prisoners not only when ordered to do so but also on their own initiative the social order of the concentration camp combined with individual propensities shaped a microcosm in which violence became endemic to workaday life the author s analysis of nazi records court testimony memoirs and film interviews illuminates the guards social backgrounds careers and motives as well as their day to day behavior during free time and on the job as they supervised prisoners on work detail and in the cell blocks conducted roll calls and selected girls and women for death in the gas chambers scrutinizing interactions and conflicts among female guards relations with male colleagues and superiors and internal hierarchies female ss guards and workaday violence shows how work routines pressure to resolve problems material gratification and nazi propaganda stressing guards roles in creating a new order heightened female overseers identification with nazi policies and radicalized their behavior

germaine tillion geneviève de gaulle anthonioz lucie aubrac and raymond aubrac were among a small number of french men and women who made the decision to resist early in the occupation in the summer of 1940 marc bloch analyzed the society in which he lived in order to identify and affirm allegiance to a france truly at odds with that which was taking shape in vichy bloch died in the resistance but his life would take on new meanings in the collective memories of postwar france confrontation with the aubracs account of their refusal to accept the unacceptable became another important way the french engaged with the resistance and its legacy the acts tillion took during the french algerian war and de gaulle anthonioz took when confronted with poverty in the france of the trentes glorieuses were of a piece with the radical nature of their earlier decision to resist evocation of the resistance provided a basis for france to reconstitute itself with honor after the war yet memory of the resistance could also pose difficult issues for future generations those who came of age in 1968 grappled with the memory of the intrepid resisters of the first years of the war whose decision to resist stood as an inspiration and a challenge historians with the imperative to take the mandate to narrate the past from historical actors to make resisters figures of history developed complex relationships with those who had resisted the essays in this collection address how resisters made sense of the wartime and postwar world in terms of their resistance and how others made sense of the resistance itself and its legacy by engaging with resisters and their histories

this book is a unique account by a survivor of both the soviet and nazi concentration camps its author margarete buber neumann was a loyal member of the german communist party from 1935 she and her second husband heinz neumann were political refugees in moscow in april 1937 neumann was arrested by the secret police and executed by the end of the year she herself was arrested in 1938 in under two dictators buber neumann describes the two years of suffering she endured in the soviet prisons and in the huge central asian concentration and slave labour camp of karaganda her extradition to the gestapo in 1940 at the time of the stalin hitler friendship pact and her five years of suffering in the nazi concentration and death camp for women ravenbrück her story displays extraordinary powers of observation and of memory as she describes her own fate as well as those of hundreds of fellow prisoners she explores the behaviour of the guards supervisors police and secret police and compares and contrasts stalin and hitler s methods of dictatorship and terror first published in swedish german and english and subsequently translated and published in a further nine languages under two dictators is harrowing in its depiction of life under the rule of two of the most brutal regimes the western world has ever seen but also an inspiring story of survival of ideology and of strength and a clarion call for the protection of democracy

this book presents the first comparative study of the works of charlotte delbo noor inayat khan and germaine tillon in relation to their vigorous struggles against nazi aggression during world war ii and the holocaust it illuminates ways in which their early lives conditioned both their political engagements during wartime and their extraordinary literary creations empowered by what lara r curtis

refers to as modes of writing resistance with skillful recourse to a remarkable variety of genres they offer compelling autobiographical reflections vivid chronicles of wartime atrocities eyewitness accounts of victims and acute perspectives on the political implications of major events their sensitive reflections of gendered subjectivity authenticate the myriad voices and visions they capture in sum this book highlights the lives and works of three courageous women who were ceaselessly committed to a noble cause during the holocaust and world war ii

this book considers tourism to memorial sites from a visitor s point of view challenging established theories in tourism and memory studies by critically appraising germany s often celebrated memory culture based on visitor observations and exit interviews this book examines how domestic and international visitors negotiate their visits to the concentration camp memorials ravenbrück and flossenbürg the house of the wannsee conference and the former stasi prison bautzen ii it argues that memorial sites are melting pots where family national and global narratives meet for german visitors the visit to memorial sites is a confrontation with germany s responsibility for the two dictatorships while for international visitors it can be a form of seeing is believing ultimately it is the immediacy of the space that is the most important part of the visit rooted in an interdisciplinary approach this book will be of interest to academics and students in german studies tourism and heritage studies museum studies public history and memory studies

this book chronicles a professor s experience with a group of us undergraduate students at holocaust memorials museums and sites of remembrance as part of a yearly holocaust study abroad program to germany and poland narrated through a series of personal encounters the ethics of teaching at sites of violence and trauma synthesizes a concrete experiential teaching account on issues ranging from trauma tourism to the ethics of spectatorship with contemporary debates on holocaust education in doing so this book seeks to offer a critical assessment on the possibilities and limitations of teaching at sites that were central to the planning and execution of the holocaust

it s 1134 in a bleak monastery somewhere in germany paul of ardiun begins the chronicle he has been ordered by his religious superiors to write the story of the knight karelian brandeis for whom paul once served as squire who fell prey to the evil wiles of a seductive sorceress thereby precipitating civil war and the downfall of a king but before paul can set down more than a sentence or two of this cautionary tale the sorceress herself magically appears to him he is a liar she tells him and always has been she lays a spell on him from this moment he will only be able to write the truth but what is the truth all his life he has rearranged his memories to suit his faith he has judged karelian judged the women judged the world now against his will an entirely different story begins to emerge

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
