the linguistics encyclopedia has been thoroughly revised and updated and a substantial new introduction which forms a concise history of the field has been added the volume offers comprehensive coverage of the major and subsidiary fields of linguistic study entries are alphabetically arranged and extensively cross referenced and include suggestions for further reading new entries include applied linguistics cognitive linguistics contrastive linguistics cross linguistic study forensic linguistics stratificational linguistics recommissioned or substantially revised entries include bilingualism and multilingualism discourse genre analysis psycholinguistics language acquisition morphology articulatory phonetics grammatical models and theories stylistics sociolinguistics critical discourse analysis for anyone with an academic or professional interest in language the linguistics encyclopedia is an indispensable reference tool

the present book offers a brief historical overview of the main scholars hence the real professors higgins 1 who played an important role in the development and study of the pronunciation of the english language the aim of the book is not to give a comprehensive account of the subject but rather to stimulate and help students of english linguistics deepen their knowledge by reading about the life and thought of some of the greatest thinkers in the field in particular the main idea of the work is that it may serve as a stimulus for students to learn something about the actual human beings who are behind the topics they have to study when attending a course of english phonetics and phonology at university especially considering that these are the people who determined although unconsciously such topics for this reason the selection of scholars illustrated here was slightly constrained by the content of the university program which means that some important linguists and also some thoughts and works of those included were left out in terms of content this work is divided into four main parts the first section professor henry higgins briefly introduces the character whose name inspired the title of the present book namely the famous professor of phonetics who was created by the irish playwright george bernard shaw for his pygmalion 1912 who also inspired the movies pygmalion 1938 and my fair lady 1964

inter alia 2 the second and third sections instead illustrate some of the most important real i e not fictional scholars who like the fictional mr higgins were interested in the sounds of the english language and largely contributed to the development of the discipline more specifically the second section the pioneers after offering a brief and more general introduction to the origins of the study of language sounds focuses on the pioneers of the field whereas the third xxi century scholars concentrates on two important linguists who played an important role in our century finally the fourth section playing mr higgins has been conceived as an opportunity for students to learn how to analyze sounds as mr higgins did through modern software programs used in acoustic phonetics such as praat which mr higgins did not have indeed despite the fact that the book cannot be exhaustive in the least it is envisaged that within this limit it could however give those few students who might become passionate about the topic a good reason for continuing to explore it further or to become the new real professor higgins of the future from the introduction

radhabinod pal was an indian jurist who achieved international fame as the judge representing india at the tokyo war crimes tribunal and dissented from the majority opinion holding that all japanese class a war criminals were not guilty of any of the charges brought against them in postwar japanese politics right wing polemicists have repeatedly utilized his dissenting judgment in their political propaganda aimed at refuting the tokyo trial s majority judgment and justifying japan s aggression gradually elevating this controversial lawyer from india to a national symbol of historical revisionism many questions have been raised about how to appropriately assess pal s dissenting judgment and pal himself were the arguments in pal s judgment sound why did he submit such a bold dissenting opinion what was the political context more fundamentally why and how did the allies ever

nominate such a lawyer as a judge for a tribunal of such great political importance how should his dissent be situated within the context of modern asian history and the development of international criminal justice what social and political circumstances in japan thrust him into such a prominent position many of these questions remain unanswered while some have been misinterpreted this book proposes answers to many of them and presents a critique of the persistent revisionist denial of war responsibility in the japanese postwar right wing movement

alphabetically arranged entries cover the history of astrology from ancient mesopotamia to the 21st century in addition to surveying the western tradition the book explores islamic indian east asian and mesoamerican astrology the field of astrology is growing rapidly as historians recognize its centrality to the intellectual life of the past and sociologists and anthropologists treat its importance in a number of modern cultures despite the historical and cultural significance of the subject most reference works on astrology focus on instructional techniques and are written by astrologers with little or no interest in the history of the topic this book instead offers an objective treatment of astrology across world history from ancient mesopotamia to the present the book provides alphabetically arranged entries by expert contributors writing on such topics as horoscopes court astrologers renaissance astrology and comets while it considers the western tradition it also treats islamic indian east asian and mesoamerican astrology in doing so it explores the role of astrology in shaping science literature religion art and other defining cultural traditions sidebars offer excerpts from various historical texts while entries provide suggestions for further reading

arnold schoenberg was a polarizing figure in twentieth century music and his works and ideas have had considerable and lasting impact on western musical life a refugee from nazi europe he spent an important part of his creative life in the united states 1933 1951 where he produced a rich variety of works and distinguished himself as an influential teacher however while his european career has received much scholarly attention surprisingly little has been written about the genesis and context of his works composed in america his interactions with americans and other émigrés and the substantial complex and fascinating performance and reception history of his music in this country author sabine feisst illuminates schoenberg s legacy and sheds a corrective light on a variety of myths about his sojourn looking at the first american performances of his works and the dissemination of his ideas among american composers in the 1910s 1920s and early 1930s she

convincingly debunks the myths surrounding schoenberg s alleged isolation in the us whereas most previous accounts of his time in the us have portrayed him as unwilling to adapt to american culture this book presents a more nuanced picture revealing a schoenberg who came to terms with his various national identities in his life and work feisst dispels lingering negative impressions about schoenberg s teaching style by focusing on his methods themselves as well as on his powerful influence on such well known students as john cage lou harrison and dika newlin schoenberg s influence is not limited to those who followed immediately in his footsteps a wide range of composers from stravinsky adherents to experimentalists to jazz and film composers were equally indebted to schoenberg as were key figures in music theory like milton babbitt and david lewin in sum schoenberg s new world contributes to a new understanding of one of the most important pioneers of musical modernism
