from the 1930s onwards all approaches are evaluated regarding their relevance for academia as well as for the general history of education if possible international references and contexts of the relevant theories are taken into account in sum the analysis not only shows how differentiated historical accounts in the field were but also reflects how current literary theory could move forward through the rediscovery of sunken ideas
