novel series that is the baby sitters club for pets summer break is just around the corner and the paws team is gearing up for a busy season full of dog walking travel and fun gabby s got a packed schedule with about a hundred different camps plus playing host to her mysterious cousin visiting from out of town meanwhile mindy is headed to her dad s house for a month long stay with so much going on the girls are looking forward to scaling back and taking it easy this summer with one exception when the opportunity to cat sit two new fur babies arises hazel jumps at the chance their new client s house is even wheelchair accessible but when everyone s hectic summer plans mean she would have to take on the job alone hazel knows her overprotective mother would never approve on the other hand managing a side business all on her own could prove that she is much more capable than her mom might think hazel soon learns that juggling multiple cats and dogs along with her own physical therapy while also keeping a big secret is no easy task when disaster strikes will she have the energy to make everything right by herself or will she be forced to reach out for help and risk getting into even more trouble

this colorful graphic novel features the philosophical and existential musings of a cat named penny told through a collection of stories penny a graphic memoir wanders through her colorful imagination as she recalls her humble beginnings on the streets of new york and waxes poetic about the realities of her sheltered life living in an apartment with her owners filled with ennui angst and vivid dreams penny proves that being a cat is more profound than we once thought a unique blend of high art and humor penny a graphic memoir perfectly portrays one cat s struggles between her animal instincts her philosophical reflections and the lush creature comforts of a life with human servants distinctive beautiful and funny reading like a highbrow garfield this unique dose of sardonic wit and cat content combines humor and storytelling with karl stevens very realistic illustration style fresh and imaginative this graphic novel feels familiar and accessible featuring one of the world s most beloved animals impressive and decorated author karl stevens has written four graphic novels and his comics have appeared

it's a terrible life jay flies the storm fighter through a terrible storm and survives but he may not be in ninjago anymore he's stranded in a frighteningly similar world where sensei wu's ninja team was never formed and the consequences are nightmarish see what has happened to this world's cole zane kai and even jay in kingdom of the snakes

back in their home village after the battle with garmadon the four ninja are hoping for some r r instead they get drawn into a fight to the finish with the most powerful and unexpected foe they have ever faced sensei wu their own sensei can the students hope to defeat the master

jay cole zane and kai battle more snakes than you can shake a stick at

lego ninjago 1 the challenge of samukai the masters of spinjitsu come to papercutz in their first graphic novel appearance written by greg farshtey the hit force behind the lego bionicle series under the tutelage of their master sensei wu the chosen four ninjas kai jay cole and zane must learn to use their elemental powers of fire ice lightning and earth their mission defeat sensei wu s evil brother garmadon and his army of skeleton warriors before they can take over the world

heartstopper meets magical boy in this heartwarming ya graphic novel full of heart adorable illustrations and a storyline every teenager can relate to teenager boo meadows s story continues in this second volume with pink hair and a very vivid imagination boo has trouble separating from the real world in her daydreams she dances beautifully at balls or fights monsters as a magical girl in reality she has a complicated

home life work stress school stress and a wicked crush on the girl of her dreams after life became too toxic to endure boo has moved out of her alcoholic mother's house can boo and mimi stick together and is dealing with mimi's unapproving mother any better than boo's mom
