seminar paper from the year 2023 in the subject egyptology language english abstract this paper highlights the life and rule of egyptian queen hatshepsut egypt was commonly referred to as the land of men as many of the rulers in egypt were men despite this several women managed to clinch power in egypt and one of them was hatshepsut other women who became the queens of egypt apart from hatshepsut include nefertiti sobekneferu and cleopatra viii historically the egyptians believed there was a difference in how men and women ruled many would ask why the egyptians believed that men were better at ruling than women which led to more kings than queens in egypt hatshepsut is different from the rest because she is the only queen who ruled for the longest time with her reign running for 22 consecutive years during her tenure she attained more glory than the other female pharaohs and even some of the kings who had ruled before her many thought she would underperform her predecessors when she came into power but she did the unimaginable as a woman egypt never embraced women rulers for they thought women were not good rulers however queen hatshepsut proved them wrong by being better than her predecessors and successors

the sixteenth century was an age of politically powerful women queens acting in their own right and female regents acting on behalf of their male relatives governed much of western europe yet even as women ruled and ruled effectively their right to do so was hotly contested men s voices have long dominated this debate but the recovery of texts by women now allows their voices long silenced to be heard once again debating women politics and power in early modern europe is a study of texts and textual production in the construction of gender society and politics in the early modern period jansen explores the gynecocracy debate and the larger humanist response to the challenge posed by female sovereignty

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
