founded at the end of world war ii in 1945 the united nations was created to maintain international peace and security develop friendly relations among nations on equal terms and encourage international cooperation in solving intractable human problems

the united nations has been called everything from the best hope of mankind to irrelevant and obsolete with this much needed introduction to the un jussi hanhimäki engages the current debate over the organizations effectiveness as he provides a clear understanding of how it was originally conceived how it has come to its present form and how it must confront new challenges in a rapidly changing world after a brief history of the united nations and its predecessor the league of nations the author examines the un s successes and failures as a guardian of international peace and security as a promoter of human rights as a protector of international law and as an engineer of socio economic development hanhimäki stresses that the un s greatest problem has been the impossibly wide gap between its ambitions and capabilities in the area of international security for instance the un has to settle conflicts be they between or within states without offending the national sovereignty of its member states and without being sidelined by strong countries as happened in the 2003 intervention of iraq hanhimäki also provides a clear accounting of the un and its various arms and organizations such as unesco and unicef and he

offers a critical overview of how effective it has been in the recent crises in Rwanda and the former Yugoslavia for example and how likely it is to meet its overall goals in the future. The United Nations Handimäki concludes is an indispensable organization that has made the world a better place but it is also a deeply flawed institution in need of constant reform. This book examines the United Nations Security Council's authorisation of the use of force, considering the extensive body of UN Security Council resolutions across its now eighty years of existence. As one of the established exceptions to the Article 2(4) UN Charter prohibition on the use of force, UN Security Council authorisation of force remains a key focus for both states and scholars alike. Despite the apparent consequences of authorisation, authorising resolutions lack prescribed formats or mandatory content. The UN Security Council has over time, however, developed a consistent practice of prior explicit authorisation. The development of this practice is reflected in a number of essential characteristics within authorising resolutions of the UN Security Council: these include explicit determinations of a threat to international peace and security, the invocation of Chapter VII or VIII of the UN Charter, the use of specific authorising language, the inclusion of time or functional limits on authorisation, and the imposition of reporting obligations on those authorised to use force. The book ultimately argues that prior explicit

authorisation constitutes a well established practice rejecting the legality and admissibility of implicit and retroactive authorisation

few episodes in recent history have aroused as much controversy as the united nations military operations in the congo this controversy has no simple straight forward and uniform explanation part of the explanation is to be found in the successes and failure of the operation itself part in its labyrinthine

international ramifications but the most important explanation lies in its significance as a precedent the ability of the organization to take collective measures to maintain law and order within the territory of a member state albeit as a means of preserving international peace was demonstrated challenged and criticized so much has been reported of the details and so varied has been the commentary that only the most intrepid spirit would venture something more with which to detain interested parties the present study does not pretend to uncover new data so as to complete or correct the historical record it attempts rather to reflect on what has already been brought out and against that background of factual knowledge to indicate and examine the legal problems involved in so doing it has been necessary to be ruthless in deciding what are central issues and in rejecting what is often interesting but probably peripheral
